INCOMING STUDENT-ATHLETE FALL CHECKLIST

Below are some ideas and links to help you be prepared as you arrive for your first semester at ECU!

2 MONTHS+ PRIOR TO ARRIVAL

- ☐ Set up your Pirate ID and ECU email ECU Email
- □ Begin reviewing the Admitted Student's Guide on PiratePort
- Complete the FAFSA & apply for ECU scholarships
- ☐ Finalize your NCAA Eligibility Center <u>Amateurism</u> Certification
- □ Verify your residency for tuition purposes
- Complete the <u>incoming student-athlete survey</u> so your athletic academic coordinator can create your course schedule
- ☐ Review your credit evaluation on PiratePort
- □ Check to see if you need to pay a \$100 enrollment deposit (This is a one-time payment)
- □ Communicate with your coaches about <u>meal plans</u> and housing options
- □ Plan to attend freshman/transfer <u>orientation</u>

1 MONTH+ PRIOR TO ARRIVAL

- Send your official final high school transcript to ECU upon HS graduation
- Submit official final college transcripts: for college transfer credit and for dual enrollment/early college credits
- Submit official test scores (AP/IB, SAT, ACT, etc) to ECU Admissions
- Communicate with your Athletic Academic Advisor about taking ECU Placement tests (<u>math</u>, <u>foreign</u> <u>language</u>) if needed
- □ Complete the <u>Student Health Services Checklist</u>
- ☐ Make sure you are up to date on immunizations; submit medical records to ECU <u>Student Health Services</u>
- □ View your bill on <u>PiratePort</u>
- Set up your <u>ECU email on your phone</u> and begin to check regularly

3 WEEKS PRIOR TO ARRIVAL

- □ Submit your <u>1Card</u> application and photo
- □ Download the ECU app on your phone
- □ Register for a <u>parking permit</u> (optional)

2 WEEKS PRIOR TO ARRIVAL

- Pay in full all tuition and fees not covered by athletic scholarship
- Make an appointment to pick up your <u>1Card when you</u> get to campus
- □ Enroll or waive out of <u>student health insurance</u>
- Complete the <u>Buckley Amendment/FERPA</u> release to give authorization for parents/family to access your college
- Begin to pack for living in a residence hall. Check out what to/not to bring.
- Gather any educational records (IEP, 504, testing, etc.) and medical records (surgeries, injuries, medications, etc.) you may share with your academic coordinator and athletic trainer
- Get your phone and laptop <u>ready to connect</u> to the eduroam wireless network on campus

FINAL ITEMS

- Move into your residence hall
- View your class <u>schedule</u>
- Use the <u>ECU campus map to familiarize yourself with</u> campus
- □ Pick up your textbooks from the SAAS study center
- Attend your team meeting and other incoming studentathlete meetings (dates TBD)
