

# INCOMING STUDENT-ATHLETE SUMMER CHECKLIST

Below are some ideas and links to help you be prepared as you arrive for your first semester at ECU!

## 1 MONTH+ PRIOR TO ARRIVAL

- □ Set up your Pirate ID and ECU email ECU Email
- ☐ Begin reviewing the Admitted Student's Guide on PiratePort
- □ Complete the summer FAFSA & apply for ECU scholarships
- ☐ Finalize your NCAA Eligibility Center <u>Amateurism</u> Certification
- □ Verify your <u>residency</u> for tuition purposes
- Complete the <u>incoming student-athlete survey</u> so your athletic academic coordinator can create your course schedule
- Submit official test scores (AP/IB/ACT, etc.) TO ECU Admissions
- Check to see if you need to pay a \$100 enrollment deposit (This is a one-time payment)
- □ Complete Student Health Services Checklist
- ☐ Make sure you are up to date on immunizations; submit medical records to ECU <u>Student Health Services</u>
- □ Communicate with your coaches about summer <u>meal</u> plans and summer housing options
- □ View your summer school bill on PiratePort

# 3 WEEKS PRIOR TO ARRIVAL

- Set up your ECU email on your phone and begin to check regularly
- □ Download the ECU app on your phone
- □ Submit your 1Card application and photo
- ☐ Make an appointment to pick up your <u>1Card</u> when you get to campus
- □ Complete the <u>Buckley Amendment/FERPA</u> release to give authorization for parents/family to access your college records

# 2 WEEKS PRIOR TO ARRIVAL

- Send your final high school transcript to ECU after graduation
- Submit official final college transcripts: for college transfer credit and for dual enrollment/early college credits
- □ Register for a summer parking permit (optional)
- □ Enroll or waive out of <u>student health insurance</u>
- Pay in full all summer tuition and fees not covered
- athletic scholarship

#### 1 WEEK PRIOR TO ARRIVAL

- Begin to pack for living in a residence hall. Check out what to/not to bring.
- □ Download the ECU Canvas app on your phone
- ☐ Gather educational records (IEP, 504, testing, etc.) and medical records (surgeries, injuries, medications, etc.) you may need to share with your academic coordinator and athletic trainer
- ☐ Get your phone and laptop <u>ready to connect</u> to the eduroam wireless network on campus

## DAY OF ARRIVAL

- Move into your residence hall
- □ Pick up your 1Card
- Meet your athletic academic coordinator
- □ View your class schedule
- □ Pick up your textbooks from the SAAS study center
- □ Use the ECU campus map to familiarize yourself with campus
- □ Follow @pirate academics on Instagram
